

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

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

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I made a list of 17 important legacies of European colonialism...

 Exploration "opens" new opportunities for economies that turn out to be "labor-scarce." Capital and land is available but labor is the scarce component. Focus is <u>contro</u>l of labor.

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- 3. The restructuring of world agriculture "cash crops" in the tropics are grown in the global South and traded to the global North for "surplus" grain.

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- Migration and re-settlement of populations toward continental "margins."

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- 10. Shift of power from "kingdom," to the joint-stock companies, to banks, as the nation-state takes over the coordinating role to organize different competing parties.

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- 14. Increased dependence on fossilized carbon that is, non-renewable energy sources and "colonial" conquest methods of capturing and controlling them.

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- 16. Because energy is thought of as scarce, "efficiency" becomes the motto, and societies become increasingly reliant of "efficient" or "engineering" solutions to complex eco-systemic and biological problems. (Futile search for "solutions" in bioengineering, geo-engineering, nuclear engineering).

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- 17. Enduring & pervasive sense of victimization leading to an expectation of apology, retribution, compensation, restitution, or revenge. Has created a sense of a "right" or entitlement to "development" based on growth and inevitable expansion like that which Europe experienced.

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


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

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


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
